The Journey Begins – Dig Deeper



What is “the way of the Lord”?



How do we know we’re following Jesus?



Are you going to commit yourself to this journey?
Ninety days of being faithful with no excuses?



Lord, I have prepared my heart with repentance and I
commit to following You wherever You lead. Thank
you for Your guidance, protection, and presence.

Matthew 1 – Dig Deeper



What is the main purpose of the three women mentioned in the genealogy?



Does Matthew demonstrate further interest in the role of women in his gospel (e.g., Matt. 14:21; 27:55)? What is his purpose?



Will you honor and serve Jesus as your King? Will you live by His word and share His gospel with all people no matter their background or differences?



Heavenly Father, thank You for making a place for me in Your kingdom. Help me to see that You never exclude anyone from seeing or hearing Your word.

Matthew 2 – Dig Deeper



What does Matthew mean, “He shall be called a Nazarene”?



In contrast to King Herod, what kind of king will Jesus be?



Have you thought about how “in Christ” we have taken a Nazirite vow, and that we too are called to submit to God’s will in all things?



Father, help me to submit my life to live for You in all circumstances. Guide and direct my steps so that I will only walk in Your paths.

Matthew 3 – Dig Deeper



Who is Jesus, according to Matthew 3?



Why is there a need for repentance in order to escape God's wrath?



Are you ready to stand before the all-powerful One? Does your witness include this great motivation for repenting? Do you declare the greatness of Jesus, and that He is the judge of the living and the dead (cf. Acts 17:31)?



Jesus, in light of Your greatness, let us humble our hearts before You and accept Your sacrifice on our behalf. Help us to tell others how You have provided an escape from the coming wrath.

Matthew 4 – Dig Deeper



When does Satan try to tempt Jesus?



How does Jesus' knowledge of Scripture guide His responses to Satan?



What do you have in place that keeps you strong in the Lord (Eph. 6:10), so that in the evil day you will be able to stand (Eph. 6:13)? Have you treasured God's word in your hearts so that you won't sin against the Lord (Ps. 119:11)?



Lord, help us to be led by Your Spirit, know Your Scriptures more, overcome Satan's temptations, and submit our hearts to Your will.

Matthew 5 – Dig Deeper



What does it mean to be great in the kingdom of heaven?



What importance does the law have for Christians?



Are you obeying and teaching God's law? Will you be called great in the kingdom?



Lord, help us to take Your word seriously, every part, even those parts that we don't understand. Let us seek to be like Jesus, the One who is truly great.

Matthew 6 – Dig Deeper



What are treasures in heaven?



How important is it to be able to see clearly when you are seeking heavenly things? Why (see Matt. 6:22-23)?



What are you pursuing? What are your goals?
Where is your heart?



Our Father, we want to have Your priorities, Your heart, and a focus on things that truly matter to You. Let us seek Your will in our relationships, possessions, goals, and ambitions.

Matthew 7 – Dig Deeper



Who are dogs and swine about whom Jesus warns?



What does Jesus mean when he tells the disciples, “Do not judge” (Matt. 7:1)?



Will you ask God for discernment in regard to your own heart? When seeking to share the gospel, will you ask for guidance, so that you are not needlessly attacked?



Dear God, help us to see our own weaknesses and need for humility in helping others. Give us Your heart for the lost, but also wisdom and discernment in our relationships.

Matthew 8 – Dig Deeper



What made the centurion's faith great? How do we also have great faith?



Why was the centurion's faith greater than others in Israel?



Do we understand how powerful Jesus is? Do we believe that He can resolve our problems with a word? Especially considering His powerful presence with us (see Matt. 28:20), do we trust Him to deliver us and those for whom we pray?



Lord, how great is Your power and willingness to help us! Let us bring our requests to You, knowing that You are able to transform our lives.

Matthew 9 – Dig Deeper



Why did the disciples not fast when Jesus was with them?



What difference does the Spirit make for fasting? What about other spiritual disciplines, like prayer and giving?



Do you recognize the Spirit's leading? Do you hear His voice when he calls you to fast?



Lord Jesus, help us to walk by the Spirit. Let us be obedient to Your word to fast, pray, and follow Jesus.

Matthew 10 – Dig Deeper



What happens when we ask the Lord of the Harvest to send out workers into His harvest field?



Why do we need Jesus so that we can come to the Father?



Do you take your mission to the lost seriously? Do you understand that people who reject your word are rejecting God Himself? Will you intercede to the Lord of the harvest to send out more workers?



Lord, we pray that You will send out more workers into Your harvest field. Send us, and give us the words of the gospel that others need to hear. May many respond and come to salvation.

Matthew 11 – Dig Deeper



Whom does Jesus invite to come to Him and find rest?



Why is it that one must come to Jesus to find rest?



Do you feel like walking in obedience to Jesus is a great burden? Does the Spirit give you the power to live according to Jesus' commands?



Lord Jesus, I come to You to find rest for my soul.
Help me to walk under God's reign that I might be pleasing in Your sight.

Matthew 12 – Dig Deeper



Why is the last state of the man worse than the first?
How could it have been prevented?



What relevance do demons and exorcisms have for today?



What does this say about our generation that focuses on living a good life, but rejects the absolute necessity of Jesus and His empowering presence? Where is your security? Is it in your character and actions or is it in the grace found in Christ alone?



Lord, open people's eyes to their need for You. Give me the words to say to my lost neighbors, friends, and family, who need to find their security in Christ alone.

Matthew 13 – Dig Deeper



How does one become an insider and not an outsider in the kingdom of heaven?



Who is responsible for a person's salvation or judgment?



Before the moment of salvation, how did you respond to God's grace throughout your life? Have you made a decision to be receptive to His word?



Lord, we come humbly before You like a child and receive the work You've done on our behalf. Thank You for Your deliverance. Help us to freely give mercy to others as You've given to us.

Matthew 14 – Dig Deeper



What causes the disciples to present what they have to Jesus?



How do we know what God wants us to do in a particular situation (e.g., send them away or feed them)?



Do we trust Jesus to meet our needs? Could God be calling us to help others, but we fail to respond because we think we're inadequate? Are we thinking big enough? Is anything too difficult for God?



Father, help us to know Your will. Let us then step out in faith, having confidence that You will meet our needs.

Matthew 15 – Dig Deeper



Who is the plant that will be uprooted?



How does the Father uproot plants that He did not plant?



Are you afraid of offending people with the gospel?
Are you more afraid of hurting people's feelings, or leaving them in a deceived state?



Lord, help us to follow only those whom You have planted. Change us from the inside out so that our actions truly reflect a pure heart.

Matthew 16 – Dig Deeper



What is the sign of the prophet Jonah?



Why didn't the Jewish leadership accept Jesus' miracles as signs pointing to who He is? If the miracles of Jesus are not signs, what were the signs Jesus' opponents were looking for?



Do we truly want God's will in all that we do? Do we barter with God to accomplish our will, even seeking for a sign, rather than submitting to His will?



Heavenly Father, thank You for revealing Your will to us. Let our lives be a sign to the world of Your saving grace and transformative power in their midst.

Matthew 17 – Dig Deeper



What did the disciples understand about John the Baptist?



Why is this understanding of John so significant for their journey with Jesus?



Are you growing in your understanding of the mysteries of the kingdom? Do you appreciate how these apply to God's will for your life?



Heavenly Father, open our eyes so that we can understand Your word and how it applies to our lives.

Matthew 18 – Dig Deeper



Why should we not look down upon anyone?



What role does your angel have before God?



If God values every believer, how can we look down on anyone? How do you keep yourself from showing contempt for those struggling with sin?



Dear heavenly Father, thank You for loving us so much, and treating us with grace rather than as we deserve. Help us to see other people the way You do.

Matthew 19 – Dig Deeper



How does Jesus feel about children?



Why are children singled out as being so important to Jesus?



Do you look down on little ones, or do you see that we must come to Christ with the faith of a child? Do you recognize the honoured place of children in the kingdom of God?



Dear God, help us to see how much children have to teach us about faith and humility. Let us come to You with the faith of a child, but also care for them, even as You delight in them.

Matthew 20 – Dig Deeper



What is the most important aspect of discipleship?



How does Jesus' healing blindness relate to salvation?



Has Jesus opened your eyes? Will you follow Jesus wherever He may lead?



Heavenly Father, thank You for having mercy on us by sending us Jesus. Open our eyes more and more so that we can follow closely after You.

Matthew 21 – Dig Deeper



Who are the leaders in God’s vineyard?



How are Christians a part of God’s vineyard (see Rom. 11:16-31)?



Are you producing the fruit that God requires? Do you understand that religion and morality without the centrality of Jesus are offensive to God? In your witnessing, do you focus on Jesus?



Dear Jesus, we submit to Your rule over Your people. Help us to honour the leaders You have placed over us. Let us be consumed with producing fruit that is pleasing to You.

Matthew 22 – Dig Deeper



How does marriage correspond to the church?



Why is our relationship with Jesus like a marriage contract?



What have you done with God's invitation to the wedding of His Son? Do you pass it on to others without making judgments as to whether they deserve it or not? Are you dressed for the banquet, clothed in Christ's righteousness?



Heavenly Father, thank You for loving us so much that You wanted to be united with us forever. Help us to respond wholeheartedly to Your invitation and to also pass it on to others.

Matthew 23 – Dig Deeper



Is Jesus telling the people to follow the teachers or the word of God presented by teachers?



How applicable is this to us who have access to God's written word? Explain.



Is your allegiance to God above everything else? If a leader you are following falls into sin, will you still follow God's word? Are you careful to ensure that your actions line up with your speech so you are not a hypocritical witness?



Dear Jesus, may we be committed to Your word above all human teachers. Give us discernment to see through the hypocrisy of man and be committed to You alone.

Matthew 24 – Dig Deeper



How certain can we be of Jesus' words coming to pass?



What “things” must take place before this generation passes away (Matt. 24:34)?



Do you find your security and safety in Jesus' words? Have you built your life on His teaching (Matt. 7:24-25)?



Dear Jesus, we desire to learn and base our lives on Your words, which can never pass away. Thank You for giving us such security in a world that is so transitory.

Matthew 25 – Dig Deeper



According to Jesus, how do we do something for Him?



Who are the least of Jesus' brothers?



How are you serving the King? Are you serving His body?



Dear Jesus, open our eyes to understand how as believers we are in Christ, and therefore also in unity with other Christians. Spirit of God, unite us with our brothers and sisters in Christ.

Matthew 26 – Dig Deeper



Why did Peter deny Jesus?



What does it mean to have little faith?



How do we avoid falling into temptation and ultimately denying Jesus? Do you make it your goal to always be watching and praying in the power of the Spirit?



Heavenly Father, draw us close to Jesus so that we always remain in right relationship with You. We commit to relying on Your Spirit for our strength so that fear of man will not control us.

Matthew 27 – Dig Deeper



Why do we have life through the death of Christ?



What does it mean that Jesus gave up His Spirit?



Do you realize the life that you have is a result of God's grace? Since He died so that you might have life, will you live for Him in the power of His Spirit?



Heavenly Father, thank You for sending Jesus to die on our behalf. Let us walk as a new creation through the life of Your Spirit.

Matthew 28 – Dig Deeper



What are disciples of Jesus to teach?



What does Jesus' Kingship mean for the believer?



Have you committed yourself to be a disciple of the King? If His commands seem like a daunting task, does it help to remember that He is always with us?



Dear Jesus, we worship You as God and King. We take courage knowing that You are always with us. Let us teach others this truth and exalt You in all we do.

Mark 1 – Dig Deeper



Why did Jesus tell the man not to saying anything?



Why did Jesus send the healed man to the priest?



Do you come to Jesus for healing? Does Jesus have the right to tell you what to do? Will you obey even if you don't understand why?



Dear Jesus, You know best in all situations. I commit to follow You even when I don't understand where You're leading.

Mark 2 – Dig Deeper



How could Jesus see the faith of the paralyzed man's friends?



Which is easier: to heal or to forgive sins? Why?



Do you have the faith of the paralyzed man and his friends? Have you experienced the forgiveness and healing that only Jesus can bring?



Thank You, Jesus, for forgiving our sins, restoring us to God, and bringing healing into every area of our lives. We submit our lives to Your authoritative rule.

Mark 3 – Dig Deeper



Who are the members of Jesus' family?



How can biological members of Jesus' family not be part of His true family? Are they saved?



Are you part of Jesus' family? Is He more important to you than anything the world offers?



Dear Jesus, thank You for making us part of Your family. I will seek to always be with You and to be pleasing in Your sight.

Mark 4 – Dig Deeper



What does Jesus mean, “If anyone has ears to hear, let him hear” (Mk. 4:23)?



How is hearing related to salvation?



Have you heard the word of God and taken it to heart? How has God given back to you according to your efforts in hearing?



Dear Jesus, give us ears to hear Your word. Let us comprehend what You are saying and have the will to carry it out.

Mark 5 – Dig Deeper



Why is the man in such torment?



Why do the people fear Jesus?



What does Jesus want to do? As Jesus' feet and hands, what will you do?



Lord, we welcome Your transforming power in our lives. Give us power to declare Your love to a lost and dying world.

Mark 6 – Dig Deeper



Why does a prophet have the least honor among his own family?



Can you think of other examples in Scripture where this is the case (see also Lk. 4:24-27)?



Have you found it difficult to witness to family or friends? In such cases of resistance to your witness, do you pray that God will raise up others as workers in His harvest?



Heavenly Father, prepare our hearts for rejection from those we love most. Save our family and friends, whether it's through our witness or through the witness of others.

Mark 7 – Dig Deeper



Why did Jesus stick his fingers in the man's ears?



In what other ways does Jesus do the things that the Father does?



Has Jesus opened your ears so that you can hear His word? Has He loosed your tongue so that you can witness for Him?



Dear Jesus, You are the awesome creator God who brings new creation life. Open our ears so that we can hear Your word. Loose our tongue so that we can witness for You.

Mark 8 – Dig Deeper



Why does Jesus touch the blind man's eyes twice?



Besides being able to see physically, what does “seeing” symbolize in Scripture (e.g., Jn. 9:39)?



Have you thought about how knowing Jesus is a supernatural experience? Do you depend on Jesus for your spiritual sight? Have you asked Jesus to open your eyes?



Dear Jesus, open our eyes that we may see You clearly. As we study Your word, bring new life to us and conform us into Your image.

Mark 9 – Dig Deeper



How is Jesus greater than Moses and Elijah?



Why did Moses and Elijah appear with Jesus at His transfiguration?



Like Peter, do we sometimes think that Jesus is one of many voices giving testimony about God? Do the words of Jesus have a place above all others in your life? Will you follow Jesus alone?



Dear Jesus, You are God's greatest revelation to us. We look to You for our example and will follow You wherever You lead.

Mark 10 – Dig Deeper



How is Bartimaeus an example of a true disciple?



What does it mean to “see” in Mark’s gospel?



Has Jesus touched your life so that you’ve been transformed like Bartimaeus? Will you follow Jesus wherever He goes?



Dear Jesus, as we study Your word, give us sight so that we can see You more clearly. Let us learn the lessons of what it means to be a true disciple.

Mark 11 – Dig Deeper



What was God's purpose for the temple?



In what ways are His people today the temple of the Holy Spirit? How do Christians fulfill the temple's purpose?



Do you realize that your body is a part of God's house, a house of prayer for all nations? Are you making sure your life is about serving God and not simply serving yourself?



Dear heavenly Father, thank You for the gracious act of making us Your temple. We pledge to worship and serve You in all we do.

Mark 12 – Dig Deeper



How does the poor widow put in more than all the others?



Explain why God usually chooses to use the weak and the poor rather than the strong and the rich?



Do you think your giving accurately reflects the way you are submitted to God? Does your faith and obedience extend to your finances?



Heavenly Father, help us to trust You with all that we have. Knowing You makes us rich, even if we have nothing else.

Mark 13 – Dig Deeper



How are Christians able to bear hatred and persecution?



Why does the world hate Christians?



Have you experienced hatred by non-Christians? Have you been tempted to turn away from your faith? Do you rejoice in God's faithfulness?



Dear Jesus, thank You for preparing us for the difficult times to come. Help us to rely on You for strength. Your grace is more than enough for us.

Mark 14 – Dig Deeper



What did the anointing of Jesus' body symbolize?



Coming immediately after the resurrection of Lazarus, what complementary aspects of the story does John's perspective add (Jn. 12:1-8)?



Like this woman, are you doing what you can on behalf of the body of Christ? If Jesus could look at His own death with such hope, can you also look at cares, crises, and tragedies through the lens of God's grace and plan (see Rom. 8:28)?



Dear Jesus, help us hold on to the good news even in the midst of difficult times. Let our hope be unshakable, as Your word is certain and true in times when things are passing away.

Mark 15 – Dig Deeper



What is the significance of the tearing of the temple curtain?



Why did the temple need to be judged?



Do you appreciate how costly Jesus' death was to God? Have you accepted Jesus' death on your behalf? Do you now live empowered to confess that Jesus is the Son of God?



Heavenly Father, thank You for sending Your Son to die on the cross for me. I know it caused You terrible grief, and I am forever grateful for Your act of love.

Mark 16 – Dig Deeper



What does Mark's gospel have in place of a post-resurrection appearance of Jesus?



After hearing the good news from the angel, why are the women afraid?



Have you had a personal encounter with Jesus Christ? Are you afraid to share your faith or do you realize that Jesus goes ahead of you to the people you must tell?



Dear Jesus, let me continue to encounter Your presence and not take my relationship with You for granted. May my journey as Your disciple be one of seeing, hearing and speaking Your glory.

Luke 1 – Dig Deeper



How does Zacharias' doubt differ from Mary's?



Why does God judge Zacharias for his doubt?



Do you believe God is able to intervene in your life in a supernatural way? When you stumble, do you place your faith in God who is able to redeem your failures?



Heavenly Father, we want to take You at your word. Help us not to doubt, but believe Your promises, no matter what man or circumstances may say.

Luke 2 – Dig Deeper



Why is it important that Jesus was fully human?



Why was it necessary that Jesus was also God?



Does it make it easier to follow Him knowing that He grew up just like anyone else? Since He took our place on the cross, will you live your life for Him, following in His footsteps?



Dear Jesus, thank You for becoming fully human and setting an example that we can follow. May we fully accept Your sacrifice and presence that make this possible.

Luke 3 – Dig Deeper



How do we escape judgment?



Who is the one who will cut down the trees? Who is the one who delivers us from judgment?



Have you accepted God's salvation, Jesus? Do you produce fruits of repentance on an ongoing basis?



Heavenly Father, thank You for loving us so much even while we were sinners. With Your Spirit's help, may we live lives of repentance and be trees that bear good fruit.

What does Jesus mean by “today”?



Do we have the same mission as Jesus?



Have you encountered the mighty presence of God’s chosen one, Jesus, who gives you His salvation? Have you experienced His good news, forgiveness, healing, deliverance from oppression, and release from bondage and debt?



Heavenly Father, thank You for fulfilling Your promises. Give us strength to live each day in the now of Your salvation.

Luke 5 – Dig Deeper



Why are Jesus' words so powerful?



What's the difference between the titles of *Master* and *Lord* when applied to Jesus?



When you encountered Jesus, was your sinfulness exposed? Have you left everything and followed Him?



Dear Jesus, even though You are the King of all, thank You for loving and caring for our every need. May we recognize that You are Lord God, and not just master. Let us listen to hear the words You speak, which are the very words of God.

Dear Jesus, when prayer was so important to You, help us to follow Your example and also spend time in prayer with You and our heavenly Father. Since You are always with us and accessible, we will develop a lifestyle of constant communion with You.

What is the significance of Jesus being called the *Lord*?



What is the meaning of God's name in the OT (see Ex. 3:12-16)?



Is Jesus *Lord* of your life? Have you experienced Jesus' compassion for your situation? Has He brought you hope for the future?



Dear Jesus, we declare that You are the Lord our God. You are compassionate and able to speak life. There is nothing You can't do. We put our hope in You alone.

Are you worried and bothered about many things?

and learning Your word a priority. Let our service for
others flow out of our love for You.

Luke 11 – Dig Deeper



How does Jesus teach us to pray?



Why does the Father give the Holy Spirit to those who are praying? What does the Holy Spirit do for us?



Are you following Jesus' instructions on prayer? Do you daily pray the essence of the Lord's Prayer?



Heavenly Father, even as we pray for sanctification, Your will, Your kingdom, the answer to our needs, forgiveness, and deliverance, we thank You for pouring out Your Spirit on us. You are more than enough for us, our needs, and our world.

Have you witnessed the faithfulness of God in the past? What can you do to trust Him more and worry less?

Do you marvel at the word of God, and His progressive plan of salvation? Are you thankful for Christ's sacrifice?



Heavenly Father, thank You for loving us so much that You sent Jesus to die for our sins. Let us come to Jesus as the One who brings forgiveness and peace with God.

bring them life, to be His hands?

fulfill Your desires and accomplish Your work.

Luke 15 – Dig Deeper

Do you have godly priorities? Does anything make you rejoice like the repentance of the lost?



Dear Jesus, thank You for loving us, even when we were astray. Give us Your heart and the priorities of heaven so that we can love others the way we've been loved.

Do you have relationships that are broken and marred by sin? Do you believe God is able to restore those relationships and bring peace? Do you have faith the size of a mustard seed?



Dear Jesus, thank You for the amazing grace You've shown us. Let us extend that grace to others, not in our own strength, but in the power of Your Spirit.

Luke 18 – Dig Deeper



In what ways are we supposed to be like the widow?



Why does Jesus use a story with an unrighteous judge?



Will you persevere in prayer until God brings justice?
Will you remain faithful until He comes (Lk. 18:8)?



Dear Jesus, we long for Your return, when You will restore all things. We will persevere in prayer and faithfulness in the midst of unrighteousness.

Do you praise God for the blessings He has given you in Christ? Are you showing yourself faithful with what He has entrusted to you?
